The aim of SICAP is to reduce poverty and promote social inclusion and equality through supporting communities and individuals using community development approaches, engagement and collaboration.

The SICAP Enterprise Officer will support the delivery of the SKDP SICAP Programme 2018 – 2022 strategic enterprise objectives and priorities including promoting self-employment as a viable and sustainable route for the SICAP target groups in South Kerry and supporting them to access self-employment opportunities. Supporting the development of Social Enterprise in South Kerry as a means of direct job creation and to contribute to a wide range of community and social services

The SICAP Enterprise Officer will work collaboratively with the SKDP SICAP team, other SKDP programmes, Local Offices of the Dept. of Employment Affairs & Social Protection and a range of other relevant organisations in developing and implementing actions to achieve the strategic priorities set out above.

Applicants should have a good educational background, holding a recognised qualification (Diploma/Degree) in accounting/business or equivalent professional qualification in an allied field of expertise, Possess at least 2 years' experience of working in a similar enterprise support & development role, Experience of working with marginalized/disadvantaged individuals and social enterprises in an enterprise support role would be a distinct advantage.

Applicants must hold a current full driving licence and have his/her own car. The contract period will run from November 2020 to December 2022 with the possibility of renewal dependent on continuing funding. The position is full time (37.5 hours per week) and the successful candidate will be employed on a fixed term contract basis to December 31st 2022. The position will be based at the South Kerry Development Partnership office at West Main Street, Cahersiveen, Co Kerry.
