The South Kerry Development Partnership CLG invites applications for the above position.

The aim of SICAP is to reduce poverty and promote social inclusion and equality through supporting communities and individuals using community development approaches, engagement and collaboration.

The SICAP Community Development Officer will be responsible for the implementation of a number of SICAP 2018-2023 Programme actions within South Kerry Development Partnership CLG and will implement actions under SICAP to support communities and target groups to engage with relevant stakeholders in identifying and addressing social exclusion and equality issues, developing the capacity of Local Community Groups, and creating more sustainable communities.

The SICAP Community Development Officer will work collaboratively with the SKDP SICAP Team and relevant agencies and community-based organisations in developing and implementing actions to: Promote community engagement and stronger communities, Build the capacity of local community groups, Support the participation of SICAP target groups and community groups in decision making structures, Promote collaborative engagement with relevant stakeholders to develop and implement initiatives to address social exclusion and inequality.

Applicants should have a good educational background, holding a recognised qualification (Diploma/Degree) in community development or equivalent professional qualification in an allied field of expertise. Possess at least 3 years' experience of working in the area of community development with a focus on working with marginalized/disadvantaged groups.

Applicants must hold a current full driving licence and have his/her own car. The position is full time (37.5 hours per week) and the successful candidate will be employed on a fixed term contract basis to December 31st 2023 with the possibility of renewal subject to funding. The position will be based at the South Kerry Development Partnership office at 2nd Floor 37 High Street, Killarney, Co Kerry, with the possibility of hybrid working arrangements.
