The South Kerry Skillnet Network Manager will drive the delivery of the South Kerry Skillnet Network's three-year strategic plan objectives. The Network Manager will lead a small team to support the circa 150 network member companies with their training and development needs over the next three years, through the provision of enterprise driven people development training programmes. Other duties will include

- Promoting the Network and the value to business of workforce development, attracting new Network Member Companies and retaining existing members.
- Proactively engaging with Member Companies on an ongoing basis to diagnose current and future industry, enterprise & talent requirements.
- Planning, procuring, coordinating and evaluating the Network's workforce development programme, including the range of training, education and Networking events delivered by the Network.
- Coordinating and/or engaging in programme development, design and customisation.
- Delivering contracted targets while adhering to the overall targets, aims and objectives of the Skillnet Network.

This position is full time – 37.5 hours per week and will be offered on a three-year fixed term contract basis to December 31st 2025 with the possibility of renewal, subject to further funding being made available. The salary scale is €47,802 to €57,923 with entry point dependant on qualifications & experience. The Network Manager will be based at the South Kerry Development Partnership Office at Library Place, Killorglin, Co Kerry with the possibility of hybrid working arrangements in accordance with SKDP's hybrid working policy.
