Access to University Course

This is a 13 week course that can lead to most full time undergraduate courses in UL. It occurs during Spring semester.

Who Can Apply?

Students under the ages of 23 years by 1st January in the calendar year of proposed entry.

Students who are not currently studying at a University or IT.

Leaving Certificate

Applicants must meet the University minimum subject requirements (2 H5 & 406/ H7) and undergraduate subject specific requirements to be considered. Please check for these requirements before you apply.

QQI Entry

Applicants using their QQI results must meet the university minimum requirements as outlined on the universities website.

HEAR Requirements

Eligibility is based on the indicators set out in the Higher Education Access Route (HEAR).
